How to use Deutsche Normalschrift handwriting fonts

Instructions

- 1. Unpack the zip archive and install both fonts Deutsche Normalschrift a.ttf and Deutsche Normalschrift b.ttf with left double click.
- 2. Open LibreOffice or Microsoft Word and choose font Deutsche Normalschrift.
- 3. Then start typing as usual:

The world is so full of a number of things, Im sure we should be as happy as kings.

As you can see above it looks nice already but it is not perfect: many letters are not linked properly. This is why we need to install both fonts. In order to use the second font we select all letters that have an unwanted space at their left side.

The w<mark>orl</mark>d is so full of a numb<mark>e</mark>r of things, Im sur<mark>e</mark> we sho<mark>u</mark>ld be as happy as kings.

Once all letter are selected choose the character property *italic*. You can also select the caracters individually. The result should look like this.
